

IN MEMORY OF BOB OWEN

FEBRUARY 14, 1959 – APRIL 13, 2026

**THE ICONIC PERSON WE CALL "BOB"** came into this world as the only child of Willa May (Smith) Owen and Harold Owen, on February 14, 1959, in Baltimore, Maryland. Coming from Norwegian (3/4) and Irish (1/4) stock, he was particularly proud of his Viking heritage.

It is with heavy hearts that we share his passing in Moab, Utah, on April 13, 2026. He joins the elders of his family, including his mother Willa May (Owen) Burns, and his Aunt Thelma Kay (Smith) Klicker, of maternal grandparents, William Smith (Irish) and Hilda Harstad (Norwegian). His father Harold, who was also an only child, predeceased him years ago, along with his paternal grandparents, Leonard and Alida Owen. He is survived by his ex-wife, Carol Bentley, cousins Kyle Klicker and Amy Klicker, along with his stepfather James Burns.

Bob grew up to be his independent self in Maryland, and once he could talk, he told his mom, "do it self." He excelled, not only in academics, but also played basketball and saxophone in high school. His wife, Carol, played the trombone. During the early party days in Moab, they would march around at night blasting their instruments. Their Halloween parties were famously well attended. Bob graduated with degrees in Mathematics and Religion from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa in 1981, and was soon offered a job at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, to assist with cardiovascular research. Five years later, he accepted a position at the University of Virginia, as a professor of cardiology. Following 10 years of experience in cardiology, he and Carol made the decision to come out west, purchasing a condo in Winter Park, Colorado, where Bob accepted a job teaching non-verbal students how to ski, in exchange for a ski pass. He often described that experience as the most rewarding job he's ever done. Bob and Carol made their way to Moab in 1991. And everyone called him "get a job Bob."

**Many in Moab and beyond considered Bob to be their best friend, and his community contributions are almost too many to name:**

**As the coffee connoisseur who established the World Headquarters of Fresh Moab Coffee (FMC),** he was committed to the highest culinary and energetic qualities. Using single-origin coffees from around the world, he roasted them to perfection in small batches on a 1917, gas-fired, Royal No. 4 machine. His wholesale roasting supported several restaurants and outdoor adventure companies, along with Moonflower Market and Horsethief Coffee at Moab Springs Ranch.

**As the inspiration for the FMC honor system,** he created a safe space for locals to gather for 19 years. People came by word of mouth, with self-serve instructions: grab fresh beans out of the hopper; pop them into a professional grinder; tamp down the espresso puck; pull a shot on an Italian lever-machine; and leave a tip. The only form of advertisement was FMC T-Shirts that you could not buy. They were only gifted, one by one, by Bob himself.

**As the Sound Engineer for KZMU** for 28 out of its 34-year existence, he was amazingly resourceful at keeping the station on the air. His volunteer DJ career started the year before, bringing 10 years of Friday night entertainment broadcasting "Burning Vinyl" with his banter-buddy, Penelope. Later, his Wednesday at noon slot brought the best new music to thirsty listeners via "Horizon Line."

**As a mountain biker and cyclist,** Bob Owen reveled in exploring and discussing the advancements in mountain bikes that were evolving while his passion for the sport was growing. They fueled his passion for both the sport and the community. He refurbished and built up many townie bikes for friends throughout our tight-knit community.

**As an owner and board member of the Moab Springs Ranch Condominium Owners Association.** Bob joined the board in 2002 and had been their president since 2009.

**As the Treasurer for one of the bowling leagues at Gravel Pit Lanes.** Bob was an avid bowler for many years, keeping books while engaging in competitive bowling tournaments.

**Last, but not least, as the FOTWON (Friend of the Way of Nature)** for his dedication and support of John P. Milton's Advanced Awareness Training group. Although not a student, he formed a close friendship with John and bonded with each participant. His infinite generosity with the use of his home and his vast knowledge of all things, resulted in deep relationships, and thus the acronym, FOTWON.

The void of life without Bob will be felt by hundreds of acquaintances, along with his family, friends, loved ones, KZMU staff and thousands of worldwide listeners.

## BLM SEEKS INPUT FOR JUNE 2026 SALE OF OIL & GAS LEASES IN UTAH

The Bureau of Land Management today announced an oil and gas lease sale scheduled for June 24, 2026, to offer 39 oil and gas parcels totaling 54,114 acres in Utah.

The BLM completed scoping on these parcels in January 2026 and held a public comment period that closed in March 2026 on the parcels and the related environmental analysis. A 30-day public protest period to receive additional public input opened today and will close **May 26, 2026.**

Leasing is the first step in the process to develop federal oil and gas resources. Before development operations can begin, an operator must submit an application for permit to drill detailing development plans. The BLM reviews applications for permits to drill, posts them for public review, conducts an environmental analysis and coordinates with state partners and stakeholders.

All parcels that are included in a federal oil and gas lease sale include appropriate stipulations to protect important natural resources. 

## Outperformers Shine Among GCHS Votech Scholarship Winners

In 2024, the local program was created to offer more support for vocational and technical interested graduates and has awarded 10 scholarships of \$3000 each over the last two years. The idea is to move some focus to training for the licensed and certified work areas that offer twice as many jobs as four-year college degrees with less time and cost. Many of these types of positions are needed locally.

After two years, how are the Grand County High School vocational scholarship winners progressing? While all are progressing, some standouts have emerged among these ambitious graduates.

Three in particular are notable.

**NICK HREN**, a 2024 graduate, completed his Diesel Mechanics certificate at USU-Price last spring and received his Associates degree in December. He worked last summer here in Moab as a diesel mechanic for Lloyd Shafer at Skyline Diesel. While at Price, he has served as a school Ambassador, recruiting students to attend there from eastern Utah and surrounding states. Nick is currently working towards a Business Education degree which he will complete in Moab while continuing as a USU-Moab ambassador recruiting for the local campus.

In his first year at Snow College in Ephraim, **JACE REIDHEAD** is in a course for Registered Nurse preparation. But with high school concurrent enrollment credits, he will finish his Associates degree in April, a year early. With only one class required this term to finish, he has taken EMT courses and may specialize in helicopter EMT work.

**BRECKIN SHEPHERD'S** story is amazing. Not too excited by high school classes, he has turned into a star in welding at Southwest Technical College in Cedar City. His motivation has put him on the Dean's List with very high marks and he has been admitted to the National Technical Honor Society. Quite a turnaround! He will finish early with a Certificate of Completion and promises of very positive job recommendations.

**NATALYA CASTILLA**, a 2024 grad, is finishing her 2nd year at Salt Lake Community College (SLCC, pronounced "slick") in fashion design. She will complete her Associates degree in May and has a fashion internship arranged for this summer. Also attending SLCC in fashion design and loving it is Rosalee Thomas. She has had several classes with Natalya. Shadis McDaniel is also attending SLCC in fashion design but doing her course work online. We look forward to learning more on her progress.

Two 2025 grads, **ABRAHAM GOMEZ** and **ALDEN "AJ" OLIVER**, are currently enrolled at USU-Moab in welding. Their instructor, Eldon Campbell, says they are doing very well. Abraham, who is finishing his second semester, will receive his Certificate of Completion in April.

**HAWK CLAPPER** is at Southern Utah University in Cedar City. Unable to get a slot in the aviation program last fall, he is currently studying business and outdoor recreation.

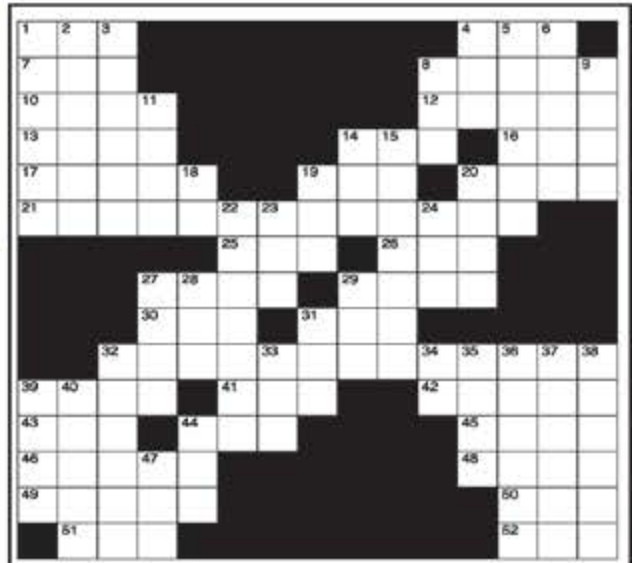

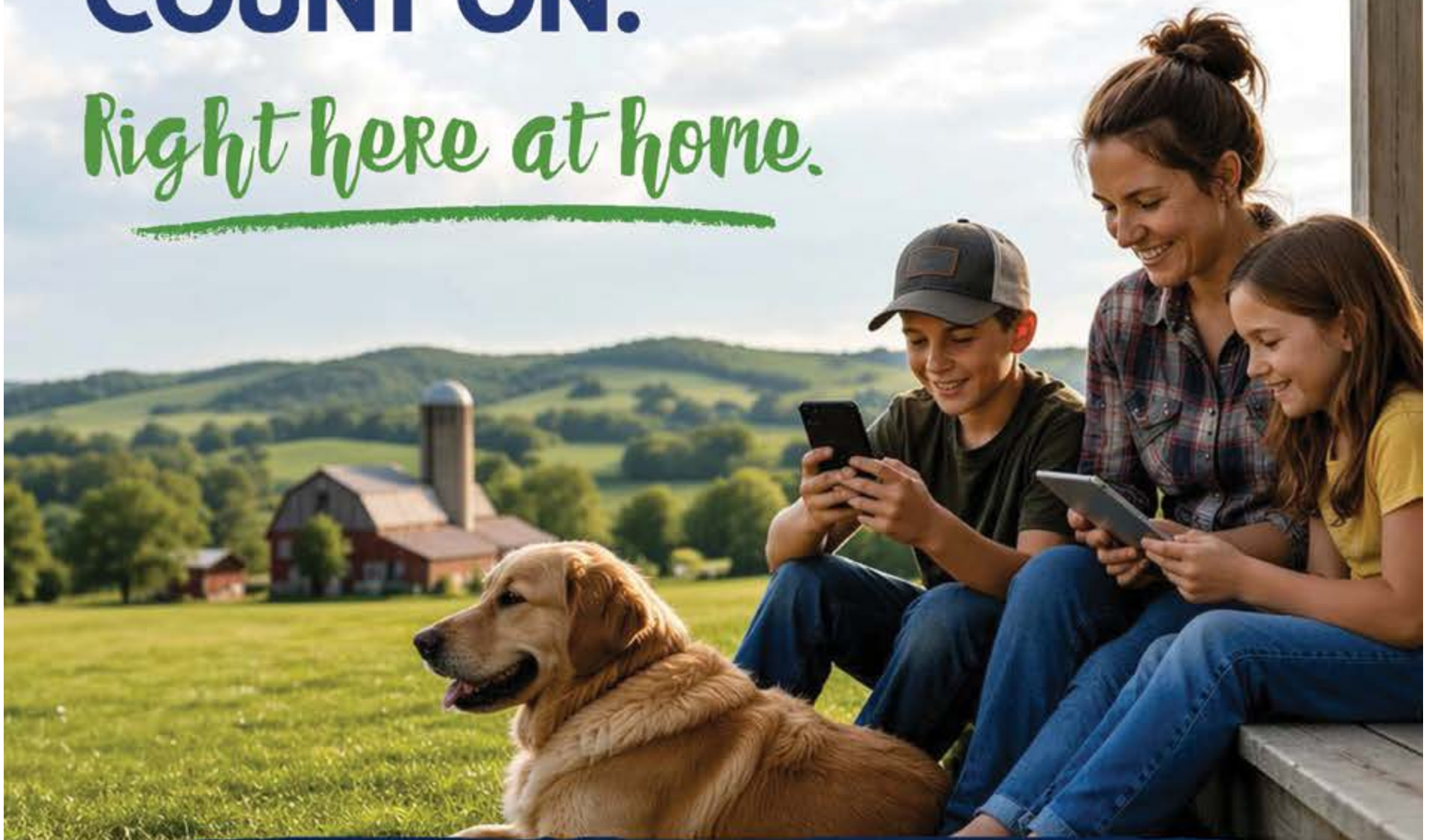
