

Beckie Lorraine Perez, 74, a beloved mother, sister, grandmother, and friend, passed away peacefully on May 19, 2026, in the arms of her daughter following a courageous battle with dementia and Alzheimer's. She spent her final days at a memory care facility in West Jordan, Utah. Even in her final chapter, Beckie continued making meaningful connections. During her time at Beehive Homes, she formed special bonds with many of the staff members there and with A+ Hospice, and they absolutely adored her. Her warmth, humor, and gentle spirit left a lasting impression on everyone fortunate enough to care for and know her.

Born in Ouray, Colorado, Beckie made Moab her home — and her heart — and the town was all the richer for it.

For nearly half a century, Beckie was a familiar and trusted face in the local business community. She managed the Prospector Lodge before beginning a long and distinguished career in hardware, first at Turner Lumber and later at Walker True Value, where she worked until her well-earned retirement. Contractors, tradespeople, and neighbors alike knew they were always in good hands with Beckie. She was the kind of boss people still talk about — fair, capable, hardworking, and genuinely invested in the people around her. A mentor to many and respected by all who knew her.

But it was outside of work where Beckie truly shined. She cherished time with family and had a gift for making space for everyone. Whether someone needed a helping hand, a laugh, or simply someone to sit beside them for a while, Beckie showed up.

She lived in the same neighborhood from the late 1970s onward, spending decades across the street from her dear friends Madge and Dave Rodman — the kind of lifelong neighborly bond that becomes family.

Beckie loved her roses, her yard, Pebbles (there was always a four-legged companion nearby), a good card game, and hosting Canasta tournaments for Heidi's friends — whom she treated like her own. She also loved reading, movies, cooking and baking, word search puzzles, dancing, and music that moved her. She lived fully, quietly, and with joy.

Beckie is survived by her daughter, Heidi Perez (Amanda); granddaughter Baelei Walby-Helphingstine (Gabe Laurio); grandsons Aiden and Gabriel Flanigan; bonus grandchildren Kaylee, Araya, and Taylyn Hinostroza; sister Donna Johnston; nephews Clint and Casey Johnston; and great-nieces Makenzie, Makayla, and Kaycee Johnston.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Addie and Donald Sim, and her brother-in-law, William "Bill" Johnston.

She will be deeply missed by her family, her friends, her community, and everyone fortunate enough to know her generous and loving spirit.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Grand County Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting on **Monday, June 22, 2026**, at 6:00 p.m. or later. The hearing will be held in person at the Grand County Commission Chambers, 125 E. Center Street, Moab, Utah 84532, and virtually via Zoom.

All interested parties are encouraged to attend in person or via electronic means. Instructions for participating via Zoom will be included in the meeting agenda, which will be posted on the County's website at least 24 hours prior to the meeting.

The purpose of this hearing is to solicit public input and consider a recommendation to the Grand County Commission regarding the proposed adoption of the Water Use and Preservation Element of the Grand County General Plan (06-01-26 Edition), an amendment to the Grand County General Plan.

The County proposes to adopt the Water Use and Preservation Element as a component of the Grand County General Plan, as required by Utah Code §17-79-403, as amended by Senate Bill 110 (2022) and Senate Bill 76 (2023). The Element applies countywide within the unincorporated areas of Grand County and addresses the effects of development on water demand and infrastructure; methods to reduce water demand for existing and future development; and opportunities for the County to reduce water waste in its own operations. The Element was prepared in cooperation with the Grand Water and Sewer Service Agency, the Thompson Special Service Water District, and the Arches Special Service District.

This proposed amendment adds the Water Use and Preservation Element (06-01-26 Edition) to the Grand County General Plan. State law requires the County's general plan to include a water element like this one. The Element is a planning guide, not a regulation. It looks at how growth affects water use and systems, and identifies ways to use less water in new and existing development and in the County's own operations. It does not regulate private property, grant water rights, or guarantee water service. Those matters remain governed by state law and the local water providers.

A complete copy of the proposed Element is available for public review during regular business hours at the Grand County Planning Department, 59 North 200 East, Moab, Utah, and is available on the Grand County Planning and Zoning Department Website.

BLM Seeks Initial Input for December 2026 Sale of Oil and Gas Leases in Utah

The Bureau of Land Management today opened a 30-day public scoping period to receive public input on 44 oil and gas parcels, totaling 74,664 acres that may be included in a December 2026 lease sale in Utah. **The scoping period ends July 16, 2026.**

Leasing is the first step in the process to develop federal oil and gas resources. Before development operations can begin, an operator must submit an application for permit to drill detailing development plans. The BLM reviews applications for permits to drill, posts them for public review, conducts an environmental analysis and coordinates with state partners and stakeholders.

All parcels that are included in a federal oil and gas lease sale include appropriate stipulations to protect important natural resources. Information on current and upcoming BLM leases is available through the National Fluid Lease Sale System. BLM lease sales are held online through Efficient Markets.

The Bureau of Land Management opened a 30-day public comment period to receive public input on plans to include 35 oil and gas parcels totaling 34,596 acres in Utah in a September 2026 sale. **The comment period ends June 22, 2026.**

The BLM completed scoping on these parcels in April 2026 and is now seeking public comment on the parcels and related environmental analysis. The BLM will use input from the public to help complete its review of each parcel.

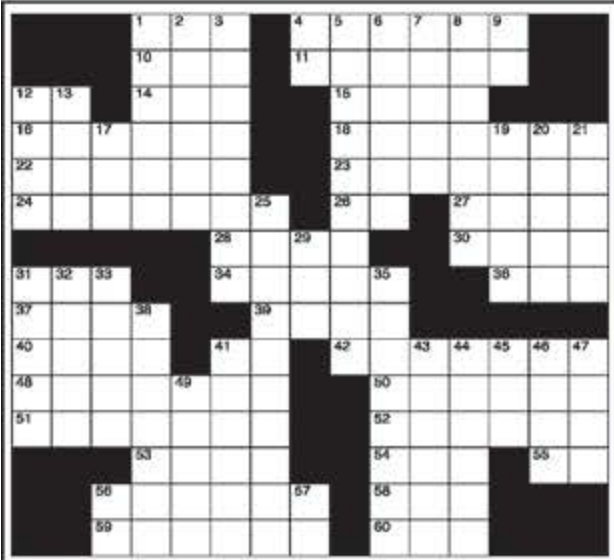

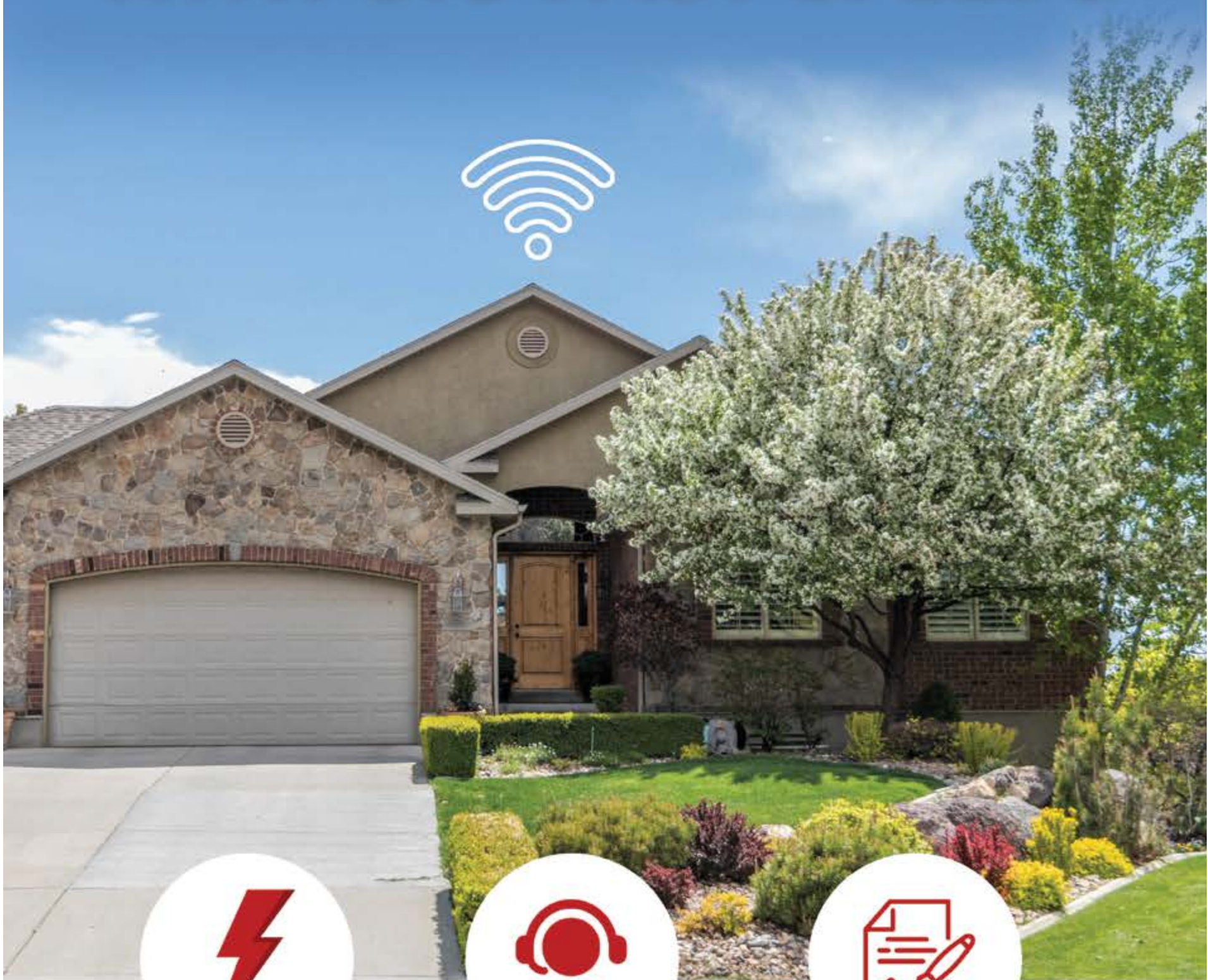
