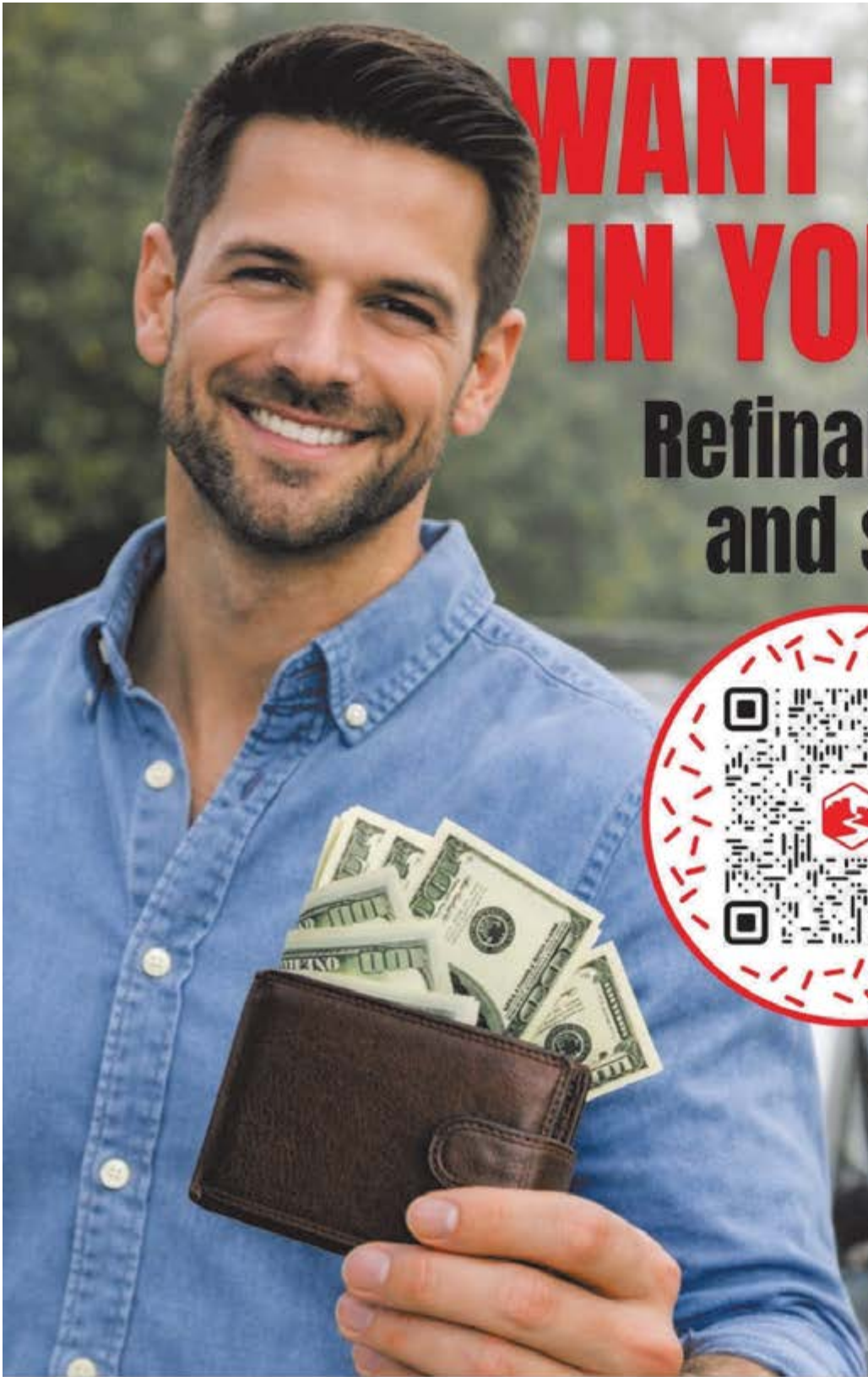

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND BONDS TO BE ISSUED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, that on July 21, 2026, the County Commission (the "Commission") of Grand County, Utah (the "Issuer"), adopted a resolution (the "Resolution") in which it authorized the issuance of the Issuer's **Transportation Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2026** (the "Series 2026 Bonds") (to be issued in one or more series and with such other series or title designation(s) as may be determined by the Issuer), and called a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to (a) the issuance of the Series 2026 Bonds and (b) any potential economic impact that the Series 2026 Project described herein to be financed with the proceeds of the Series 2026 Bonds may have on the private sector.

The Issuer shall hold a public hearing on **AUGUST 18, 2026, at the hour of 6:00 p.m.** at 125 East Center, Moab, Utah. The purpose of the hearing is to receive input from the public with respect to (a) the issuance of the Series 2026 Bonds and (b) any potential economic impact that the Series 2026 Project (defined below) to be financed with the proceeds of the Series 2026 Bonds may have on the private sector. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate.

The Series 2026 Bonds will be issued for the purpose of (a) financing all or a portion of the construction of storm drainage improvements, including storm drainage pipelines, manholes and catch basins and related improvements (collectively, the "Series 2026 Project") and (b) paying costs of issuance of the Series 2026 Bonds. **PARAMETERS OF THE SERIES 2026 BONDS** The Issuer intends to issue the Series 2026 Bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not more than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), to mature in not more than thirty-three (33) years from their date or dates, to be sold at a price not less than ninety-eight percent (98%) of the total principal amount thereof, and bearing interest at a rate or rates not to exceed two and a half percent (2.50%) per annum. The Series 2026 Bonds are to be issued and sold by the Issuer pursuant to the Resolution, including as part of said Resolution, a Master Resolution (the "Master Resolution") which were before the Commission and attached to the Resolution in substantially final form at the time of the adoption of the Resolution and said Master Resolution is to be executed by the Issuer in such form and with such changes thereto as shall be approved by the Issuer; provided that the principal amount, interest rate or rates, maturity, and discount of the Series 2026 Bonds will not exceed the maximums set forth above. The Issuer reserves the right to not issue the Series 2026 Bonds for any reason and at any time up to the issuance of the Series 2026 Bonds.

TRANSPORTATION TAXES PROPOSED TO BE PLEDGED

The Issuer proposes to pledge all or any portion of the revenues produced by County Option Sales and Use Tax for Highways and Public Transit levied by the Issuer pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 12, Part 22, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended (the "Revenues") for the Series 2026 Project. **OUTSTANDING BONDS SECURED BY PLEDGED TAXES** The Issuer currently has \$0 of bonds outstanding secured by the Revenues. **OTHER OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE ISSUER** Additional information regarding the Issuer's outstanding bonds or obligations may be found in the Issuer's financial report (the "Financial Report") at: <https://reporting.auditor.utah.gov/searchreports/s/>. Based on the Issuer's current plan of finance and a current estimate of interest rates, the total principal and interest cost of the Series 2026 Bonds if held until maturity is \$1,053,353.50. A copy of the Resolution and the Master Resolution are on file in the office of the County Clerk/Auditor, 125 East Center, Moab, Utah, where they may be examined during regular business hours of the County Clerk/Auditor from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for a period of at least thirty (30) days from and after the date of publication of this notice. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a period of thirty (30) days from and after the date of the publication of this notice is provided by law during which (i) any person in interest shall have the right to contest the legality of the Resolution, the Master Resolution (as it pertains to the Series 2026 Bonds), or the Series 2026 Bonds, or any provision made for the security and payment of the Series 2026 Bonds, and that after such time, no one shall have any cause of action to contest the regularity, formality, or legality thereof for any cause whatsoever.

Pack Creek Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Channel Restoration Project

All interested parties are encouraged to attend in person or via electronic means. **The purpose of this hearing is to solicit public input on a proposed ordinance amending Conditions #1 and #3 of Ordinance No. 725 (2025), which applied the Major Utility Overlay to a portion of Parcel No. 02-0021-0113 (City of Moab Water Tank Site). Condition #3 sets the project completion deadline.** Condition #1 requires a Development Agreement, and would be amended to track the language of LUC § 4.10.1. Under Grand County Land Use Code ("LUC") § 4.10.1, a Major Utility Overlay is required for development of a major utility listed in LUC § 4.10.2, and is applied by a rezone application processed under the procedure in LUC § 9.2, Text and Zoning Map Amendments (Rezoning), with approval from the County Commission. Because the Major Utility Overlay is applied by rezone, the proposed amendment is being processed under that same procedure, including review by and recommendation from the Planning Commission and approval by the County Commission. **The Grand County Planning Commission is scheduled to hold a public hearing on the proposed ordinance on August 3, 2026 and to forward a recommendation to the Commission.** Following the public hearing, the Commission may adopt, adopt with changes, or deny the proposed ordinance.

The property is the City of Moab water tank site. A water storage tank is a major utility listed in LUC § 4.10.2 and requires the Major Utility Overlay. The Major Utility Overlay applied by Ordinance No. 725 covers approximately 2.848 acres of the parcel identified as Parcel No. 02-0021-0113. Approximately 2.848 acres of a (+/-)23.11-acre parcel

This ordinance changes two of the four conditions the County attached when it approved a Major Utility Overlay for the City of Moab's water tank site in November 2025. Condition #3 required the work to be finished within the state grant timeframe and set that date as December 31, 2025. The City had to find a different funding source and has since obtained a grant extension and tentative funding from the Utah Division of Water Resources, so the ordinance replaces the December 31, 2025 date with December 25, 2027 and allows the Planning Director to extend that date for good cause. Condition #1 requires a Development Agreement. The wording of that condition does not match the County's own Land Use Code, so the ordinance rewrites it to use the Code's language - an agreement between the property owner and the County setting out specific measures to reduce the effects the facility may have on surrounding property.

The Development Agreement is still required; only the wording changes. Nothing else changes - not the overlay, not its boundary, not the zoning, not the approved use, and not Conditions #2 or #4.

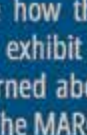

Don't Leave Your Pet in the Car!

A car can overheat **even** when the window has been left cracked an inch or two.

Young, overweight or elderly animals, or those with short muzzles or thick or dark-colored coats are **most at risk** for overheating.

Shady spots offer **little** protection on hot days, and move with the sun.

90°

Even if the temperature outside is only 70°, the inside of your car may be as much as 20 degrees hotter!

102°

On an 85° day, it only takes ten minutes for the inside of your car to reach 102°.

120°

Within just 30 minutes, the car's interior can climb from 85° to a scorching 120°.

Many states and local governments have laws that prohibit leaving an animal unattended in a motor vehicle under dangerous conditions, which includes hot days. Your car could be damaged or you could be charged with a crime.

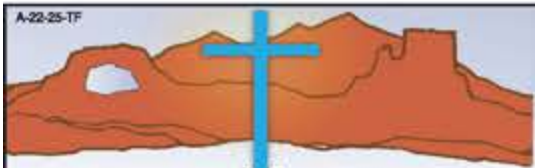

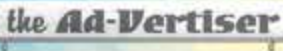
