Arroyo Crossing Phase II Infrastructure Construction A Project Supported by the State of Utah Community Development Block Grant Program Grand County is accepting bids for the construction of roadways, sewer, water, electrical, and irrigation infrastructure as part of the Arroyo Crossing Phase II Infrastructure Construction Project, located at the Arroyo Crossing Subdivision, approximately 2022 S Spanish Valley Drive, Moab, UT 84532.

Scope of work: The project will consist of the construction of infrastructure, earthwork and roadways to serve approximately 116 future affordable housing units at the Arroyo Crossing community land trust subdivision. Specific project improvements include the excavation and construction of two roadways and installation of water, sewer, and irrigation mains, trenching and installation of electrical conduit, and a storm drainage system. The approximate project area is 4.8 acres. Gas utility is not proposed as part of this project.

A copy of the Plans and Complete Bid Package is available electronically at grandcountyutah.gov/bids.aspx or moabclt.org/bidding. This project is partially funded through a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

The contractor will be required to comply with all federal labor standards and attendant laws, including the payment of the most current Davis-Bacon wages and compliance with Section 3 to provide employment opportunities of lower income persons. Local, minority and woman-owned business owners are encouraged to bid. The lowest responsible bidder will be selected.

Taxpayers deserve a county government that works, one where employees show up, do their jobs, feel safe and deliver results for the community. Recent allegations stating that I and others are creating a hostile work environment are simply not true, and are only creating liability and eroding trust. (.....) Staffing challenges have existed at the county since at least 2020, long before I joined the commission in 2023 and became chair at the beginning of this year. Turnover has been significant. Between 2020-2024, 10 employees left Tourism and Economic Development and another 11 left the Planning and Zoning Department.

As commission chair, I am determined to see county staffing challenges addressed and resolved in a lasting way through proper process, not through political games. County employees deserve a workplace when they can be productive, effective and supported. That is why I fully support the county engaging an independent third party to conduct an investigation to ensure all allegations are reviewed thoroughly.

The people of Grand County elected the new commission to clean up dysfunction, focus on results, and deliver real outcomes for families, local workers and businesses. That is what we are doing. I am committed to restoring accountability and transparency in the county. Success should not be measured by the likes, shares, memes and viral comments that seem to dominate our public discourse. This only serves to divide us and damage relationships and progress.

Success should be measured by real, positive outcomes for the people we serve (.....) by working toward solutions that serve our entire community. Regardless, I will keep doing the work: raising standards, providing a safe and stable environment for staff, and delivering results locals can see. That is how we rebuild trust and move Grand County forward.

ADOPTION OF GRAND COUNTY ORDINANCE 720

The Grand County Commission adopted Ordinance 720 in open session on July 1, 2025. This Ordinance amends the Grand County Land Use Code - 4.7 High Density Housing Overlay. All vote was approved 6-1 with Commissioner McGann Opposed. A complete copy of the Ordinance is available at the Grand County Clerk's Office at 125 E. Center St., Moab, Utah. This Ordinance will take effect July 15, 2025.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY TEST PROJECT

UDOT and the City of Moab are testing the use of temporary rubber curb extensions (bulb-outs) to enhance pedestrian safety in downtown Moab.

PUBLIC FEEDBACK will help determine if permanent concrete bulb-outs should be installed.

HOW BULB-OUTS BENEFIT PEDESTRIANS AND DRIVERS SAFETY:

- Shorter crossing distances
- Encourage reduced vehicle speeds & turning speeds
- Discourage illegal parking near crosswalks

VISIBILITY:

- Pedestrians are closer to the travel lanes and more easily seen by approaching drivers

WALKABILITY:

- Additional space on the sidewalk for pedestrian waiting areas
- Create a more comfortable & safer space for pedestrians waiting to cross the street

NOTE: The *TEMPORARY RUBBER CURB EXTENSIONS* at Main and Center Street & Main and 100 North will be in place for approximately 2 to 3 months while data and public comments are collected.

If this temporary test project is successful, the City of Moab and UDOT will work together to seek funding for the installation of permanent concrete bulb-outs.

Permanent bulb-outs would be similar in appearance to those already at some intersections in downtown Moab.

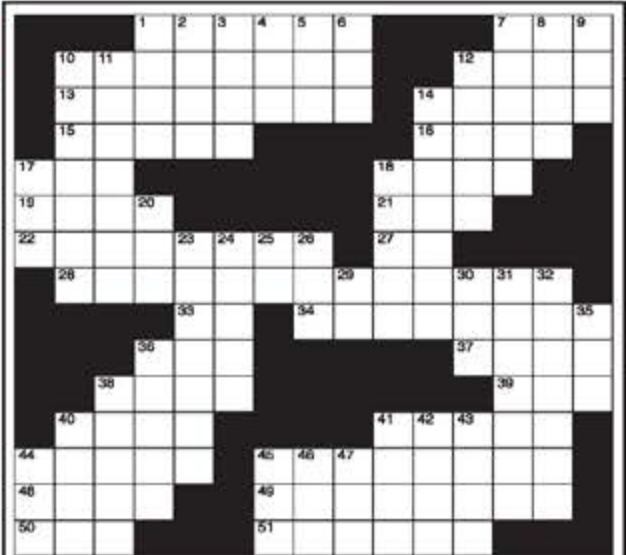
